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I. SUMMARY OF CHANGES: The purpose of this Change Request (CR) is to allow VMS users to copy over existing SuperOp Sequences (Active/Inactive/Archived).

# II. GENERAL INFORMATION

# A. Background:

In the SuperOp subsystem, the DME MACs currently only have the ability to copy a SuperOp sequence to a SuperOp sequence that does not exist. The DME MACs would like the functionality to copy over an existing edit.

Currently, if the user wants to copy a SuperOp Event/Sequence to an Event/Sequence that already exists, VMS generates the SE31 error message. Then, the user has to manually update the existing sequence with the correct information. Allowing the user to copy over an existing edit will save the MACs time and would help prevent errors. This CR will give the DME MACs the ability to replace active (PA or TA status), inactive (PI or TI status), and archived (SI status) sequences in SuperOp. It will also provide a confirmation question that allows users to type "Y" or "N" to complete or cancel the copy when the sequence already exists.
