I. SUMMARY OF CHANGES: The purpose of this Change Request (CR) is to implement a change to the current ADR process that separates the PA ADRs from the other medical review workload.

II. GENERAL INFORMATION

A. Background: In the FISS ADR process, claims are suspended to batch location SB6001 until the initial ADR is generated. Currently, SB6001 is used for all medical review workloads.

The Medicare Administrative Contractors (MACs) would benefit from separating the other medical review workloads from the PA claims. A separate ADR location will allow MACs to readily identify claims that are specific to their departmental workload and ensure that PA and MR claims are separated from workload and reporting perspectives. This UECR will enhance the FISS batch ADR process to create a unique location for PA claims.

B. Policy: There is no policy impact. This change will enhance the existing automated ADR process to separate the medical review workload from the PA claims.
